Subject: Parking Services
Year 2003 Annual Maintenance Program

Action
Requested: Approval to Proceed with Project

Background:

The Parking Services annual safety, maintenance and repairs program is comprised of several major projects, minor improvements to several parking lots, annual maintenance to parking structures, lighting and landscaping improvements. Major projects include structural repairs for Church Street Parking Structure, expansion of the State Street Commuter Lot, and the expansion and improvement of parking facilities at the Botanical Gardens.

This program is estimated to cost \$2,850,000 with funding provided from Parking Services revenues. The construction is scheduled to coincide with the summer paving season. The University of Michigan Plant Extension – Architecture, Engineering and Construction will manage the projects.

We recommend that the Regents approve the Parking Services Year 2003 Annual Maintenance Program project as described, and authorize issuing the project for bids and awarding construction contracts providing that bids are within the approved budget.
